EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Participates in and coordinates clinical psychological services for complex individuals including reviewing, analyzing and calculating data, writing reviews (quarterly, six month, annual) and presenting restrictive programs to the appropriate over-site committees. Develops, implements and trains staff on behavior programs for individuals with complex mental, emotional and/or social problems. Attends team meetings on a monthly, quarterly, annual and as needed basis. Attends community based psychiatric appointments. Performs related duties as required.

EXPERIENCE & TRAINING

General Experience: A doctorate degree in clinical or counseling psychology and one (1) year's post doctoral experience as a psychologist working under the supervision of a licensed psychologist.

Special Requirements: 1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice psychology in Connecticut. Any person employed by the State of Connecticut prior to July 1, 1985 with a title in the Psychology series of the classified service shall be exempt from the above licensure requirement pursuant to Public Act 613, Section 119(c). For certain positions the appointing authority may require state licensure. 2. Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of American Sign Language. 3. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.
