Central Connecticut State University invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track, Assistant/Associate Professor. The successful candidate will use molecular and cellular approaches to study problems in pharmacology and physiology. The Department values excellent teaching in the classroom and in the laboratory. Beyond the classroom, we mentor students in multi-semester independent research experiences as an integral part of our program. The new faculty member will have a desire and ability to establish a student-centered research program for undergraduate and master's level students.

The candidate will teach introductory undergraduate courses for Biomolecular Sciences majors and for non-majors; teach upper level courses for the majors in Physiology (Human and Comparative), Pharmacology, and Anatomy and Physiology; teach one graduate-level course in their area of expertise; and maintain an active, non-clinical research program using a system amenable to research involving undergraduate and Master's level students. Candidates are expected to be committed to multiculturalism and working with a diverse student body.

- Ph.D. in Pharmacology, Physiology, or a related field
- Teaching experience
- Excellent communication skills
- Demonstrated ability for creative research
- Commitment to serving a culturally and ethnically diverse student body
