This position is located at the South Campus of the Albert J. Solnit Children's Center in Middletown, CT, a school operated within a psychiatric facility for children and youth. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: the planning for and direct instruction of students, participation in planning and placement team (PPT) meetings, conducting student assessments, and implementing curriculum which is aligned with CT's Curriculum Frameworks. Additional duties include participating in treatment team conferences, assessing and managing student behavior; maintaining student academic records and evaluating student progress.

General Experience: Bachelor's degree from an accredited university or college. This position requires a certification in Family and Consumer Science, #045. An additional certification in special education or experience with educational principles, methods, and techniques when working with students with behavioral challenges is preferred. Experience in an educational program within a residential treatment facility and experience with a culturally diverse student population is also preferred.
