They should also be able to provide evidence of the use innovative and learner-centered approaches to teaching mathematics and a commitment to the mission of a comprehensive community college with an urban, non-traditional, multicultural student population.

Under the supervision of the Science & Mathematics Department Chair, the faculty member of Developmental Mathematics will prepare and teach college-approved Mathematics courses in accordance with course descriptions and class schedules, develop course syllabi, participate in the assessment of student learning of mathematics, and meet the responsibilities of all faculty members, including academic advising.
