The Department of Children and Families/CJTS is seeking a part-time, (24 hour), 1st shift Head Nurse at the Connecticut Juvenile Training School Campus in Middletown, CT. Working every 3rd Weekend; hours are 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. three (3) days per week.

Examples of Duties: Responsibilities include administering medications; conducting nursing assessments, providing admission and discharge nursing assessments including plans for continuing care; maintaining records and making reports; providing nursing services in compliance with standards of excellence for nursing care; participating as a member of an interdisciplinary team in the assessment, development, implementation and evaluation of resident treatment plans; managing an assigned case load; health education resource to an assigned unit; collaborative member with health care team. General Experience: Two (2) years of experience as a Registered Professional Nurse.

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been working with the type of patients and/or clients serviced by the agency.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license or temporary permit as a Registered Professional Nurse in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of the American Sign Language in certain designated positions. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.
