Example of Duties: This position is located at the Riverview School at the Albert J. Solnit Children's Center in Middletown, CT, a school operated within a psychiatric facility for children and youth. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: providing instructional support services to students working under the direct supervision of a classroom teacher, assisting in the implementation of Individual Education Programs (IEPs), Provides one-to-one tutoring for eligible students, assisting with classroom management, organizing instructional and other materials, assists students in participating in general school activities, responsible for safety and personal conduct of students, supervising students in groups or individually in the classroom during the school day, assists teacher with routine classroom procedures and provides assistance in the computer laboratory.

General Experience: High school diploma or General Educational Development test (GED Certification) and two (2) years of college credit; preference will be given to those who have passed the State Board of Education Paraprofessional Assessment.

Substitutions Allowed: Passing a State Board of Education adopted Paraprofessional Assessment which assesses content knowledge in mathematics, reading, and writing and an understanding of how to assist in the instruction of these topics may be substituted for the two (2) years of college credit.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class maybe required to possess and retain a current Connecticut Motor Vehicle operator license.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be required to lift light to medium weights and be exposed to some risk of injury from assaultive or abusive students.
