Responsibilities include but are not limited to: Assists in preparation, handling, serving, and distribution of food; cleans food service areas, including preparation, storage, delivery and recycling areas, prepares simple foods such as beverages, salads, sandwiches, toast, etc.; prepares juices, coffee, etc.; replenishes serving trays and condiments; stocks shelves with supplies, access control equipment, cleans all areas of the foodservice department and common areas in the adjacent building. Cleans food preparation equipment and performs related duties as required. Applicants with experience in food service maintenance preferred.
