The Department of Children and Families, Adolescent and Juvenile Services Division, Congregate Care Unit, is recruiting for one (1) full time (37.5) hours (first shift) Clinical Social Worker Associate. This position is located in Central Office in Hartford, but travel is required to conduct site visits and attend meetings at various locations across the State.

This position is responsible for providing technical assistance and clinical consultation to a cohort of residential programs in Connecticut. This position will work in partnership with the regional offices, the Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership, and community providers to ensure the delivery of quality services to youth in these placements.

Candidates must have knowledge of and preferably direct experience in providing evidence based treatment modalities and best practices, group home and residential programming, and in community based services. Experience working with adolescents is preferred. Ideal candidates will also have a strengths-based approach to assessment and treatment and will also have strong skills for provider relations, including problem solving, and communication (both verbal and written).

General Experience: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Requirement: Candidates must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Section 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes and have.
