**Example of Duties:** Responsibilities will include but not be limited to: the design, implementation and oversight of a multi modality rehabilitation department including therapeutic recreation, occupational therapy, music therapy, etc. This position also holds direct care responsibilities including assessment, and individual and group treatment, supervises Rehabilitation Therapists, Rehabilitation Therapy Assistants, Summer Workers and Interns, serves as the Adventure Based Counseling Course Manager, ensures clinical documentation including progress notes and treatment planning; and ensures discharge planning related to client's rehabilitation needs. Applicants with experience working in a congregate behavioral health setting with children/adolescents preferred.

**Eligibility Requirement:** Qualified applicants must have passed and be on the current examination list for Rehabilitation Therapy Supervisor 1 promulgated by the CT Department of Administrative Services (DAS) by date of appointment. Current CT state employees may apply for lateral transfer if they have attained permanent status in the title of Rehabilitation Therapy Supervisor 1. Current DCF employees having permanent status in this classification must submit a 1199 Lateral Transfer Request form.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Considerable knowledge of principles and practices of a designated therapeutic discipline; considerable knowledge of physical, mental and/or psychosocial disorders; knowledge of community services; knowledge of individual and group dynamics; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; skill in instructing and supervising in practice of specific therapeutic disciplines; ability to plan, implement and evaluate therapeutic programs.

**Working Conditions:** Incumbents in this class may be exposed to some danger of injury and to moderately disagreeable conditions while providing treatment to clients and/or patients.
