Eligibility Requirement:

The Connecticut Juvenile Training School is seeking applicants for a Maintainer in the Food Services Department in Middletown, Connecticut. This position is full-time, 37.50 hours per week (11:00 am – 6:30 pm) schedule is as follow: week 1, off Friday and Monday, week 2, off Saturday and Sunday. Candidates are required to have knowledge handling food, assist in preparation, serving and distribution of food, cleaning storage, delivery, recycling and service areas. Replenishing and stocking shelves in the preparation and serving area. Overseeing student workers assigned to the kitchen. Applicants should be physically fit and able to pass annual certification in Safe Crisis Management - the verbal and physical intervention techniques used at the Connecticut Juvenile Training school. Experience in the Food Service department and in a secure facility is preferred. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Some interpersonal skills; some oral and written communication skills; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to learn policies and procedures; ability to operate, care for and perform minor maintenance on tools and equipment used in daily work; some ability in simple record keeping.

General Experience:

Any experience and training which provide the knowledge, skills and abilities listed above.

Special Requirement:

Incumbents in this class may be required to possess appropriate current licenses or permits.

Physical Requirement:

Employees appointed to positions in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility, visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties of the class. A physical examination may be required.

Working Conditions:

1. Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate to heavy weights and may be exposed to extreme weather conditions and risk of injury from equipment and assaultive and/or abusive patients and/or clients.
2. Incumbents in this class may be required to complete an asbestos removal program consistent with EPA guidelines for operations and maintenance and use protective equipment such as respirators and safety goggles.
