**Eligibility Requirement:** The Department of Children and Families currently has a vacancy for a [Psychiatrist \(Per Diem\)](#) at the Connecticut Juvenile Training School - Girls Unit. The DCF Girls secure Unit will be a short term rapid reintegration unit for girls in need of brief stabilization. It will respond to the needs of the congregate care programs and girls in the community whom need to be returned to secure care for a short time. There will also be some emergency bed capacity. The Girls Unit is located at Solnit Center South Campus - 915 River Road, Middletown, CT 06457. Preference will be given to applicants with experience working with adolescent girls committed to provide gender responsive, family focused and trauma informed care. Applicants must be skilled at working within a therapeutic milieu with an emphasis on teaching and engagement. It is also preferred that applicants have experience in the delivery of Dialectic Behavioral Therapy (DBT) and Trauma-Based Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT). Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice child and adolescent psychiatry in Connecticut.

No permanent State Employee may work in a per diem position.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Knowledge of principles and practices of medicine with particular reference to diagnosis and treatment of mentally disturbed clients; knowledge of recent developments in field of psychiatric medicine; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; skill in mental and physical diagnosis; some supervisory ability.

**General Experience:**

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain a license to practice medicine and surgery issued by the Connecticut Department of Public Health in accordance with the applicable Connecticut General Statutes. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year.
2. Incumbents in this class must have completed at least one (1) year of residency program experience in psychiatry approved by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME.)
