**Examples of Duties:** Responsible for the operations and functions of Camp Quinebaug. Organizes, plans, coordinates and manages day camp programs; supervises assigned staff and volunteers; responsible for care and safety of all program participants; prepares reports and monitors supplies and equipment; instructs others in coordinated care of campers; trains staff in camp operations and camper care; communicates with families and school district personnel; implements staff directives; performs related duties as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED**

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:** Must be certified in CPR for the Professional Rescuer, must be age 21 or older, shall not have been convicted of any offense involving moral turpitude and be of good character, shall be certified as mentally competent by a physician, shall not use improperly any narcotic or controlled drug, shall have had at least sixteen (16) weeks of administrative or supervisory experience in an organized camp OR already served at least one (1) summer as a Camp Director.

Must successfully complete training in the following classes:

- Valid C.P. R. Certification
- Annual Abuse & Neglect Training for children and adults
- DDS P.M.T. Training
- DDS Infection Control
- DDS Water Safety Training
- Emergency Preparedness Training
- Fire Safety Training

**Note:** Must be approved to serve in this capacity by the Department of Public Health. A separate application must be completed for selected candidate. A valid physical exam conducted no more than 36 months prior to 8/8/2016 must be provided prior to employment.
