**Examples of Duties:** Supervises and responsible for organizing, planning and managing a comprehensive summer boating activities program and related activities; supervises work and assignments of lifeguards, volunteers or other summer workers at the camp; responsible for appropriate implementation of Department’s Water Safety Policy & Procedure; trains staff in water safety; teaches campers and staff in acceptable procedures in operation of row boats, paddle boats and canoes; adapts program for each camper; ensures safety of all boating activities, camper and staff welfare in and around the water; ensures equipment safety and maintenance; may provide direct camper care and supervision; performs related duties as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

  - 5. Ellis and Associates course completion or license for ILTP (for special facilities); **and**
- D. Must have completed one of the following courses in the type of small craft for which they are responsible:
  - 1. American Red Cross Fundamentals of Canoeing Course; A.R.C. Basic Sailing Course (Start Sailing Right); A.R.C. Basic Rowing course; A.R.C. Basic River Canoeing (for river/white water); A.R.C. Fundamentals of Kayaking; A.R.C. Small Craft Safety for Canoeing, Kayaking, Sailing, Rowing and Moving Water; ARC Basic River Kayaking;
  - 2. Boy Scouts Aquatic Instructor Certification (for rowing/river canoeing/flat water canoeing/sailing/motor boating)
  - 3. American Canoe Association-Coastal Kayak Basic Strokes and Rescues (for river/white water), Essentials of River Canoeing (for river/white water), Essentials of Canoe Touring for flat water), Essentials of Kayak Touring (for flat water)
