**Examples of Duties:** Provides lifeguard services for campers and staff as needed in all waterfront areas; performs first aid duties and/or CPR as required; performs work necessary for upkeep of area; operates and maintains emergency equipment; instructs campers and staff in water safety; lifts disabled campers as necessary.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED**

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:** Must possess Certification in the following: Life-saving from a national accredited organization (i.e. American Red Cross, YMCA, Ellis & Associates, etc.), cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for the professional rescuer, and first aid. All certifications must be valid from the beginning to end of working period.

**All Camp Personnel require a minimum of the following :**

1. Be at least eighteen (18) years old prior to June 13, 2016 (DPH requires some positions be at least age 20 or 21)

**Must successfully complete the following:**

2. Valid C.P. R. Certification
3. Annual Abuse & Neglect Training for children and adults
4. DDS P.M.T. Training
5. DDS Infection Control
6. DDS Water Safety Training
7. Emergency Preparedness Training
8. Fire Safety Training

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable. **A valid physical exam conducted no more than 36 months prior to 8/8/15 must be provided prior to employment.**
