Examples of Duties: Nursing responsibilities are consistent with Clinical Nurse Coordinator job specifications. This position will serve as a resource/consultant to individuals living in the community with their families in the Eastern half of the South Region, as well as to staff and community agencies and practitioners; may include Family Training as a Medicaid Waiver service. May make home visits, conduct nursing assessments and participate in OPA investigations, including assisting with IPSP and PSP responses and with individuals in temporary nursing home/rehab placements; maintains accurate written and/or electronic data and reports. This position will also provide nursing coordination for individuals in the Community companion homes. Participates in the Regional On-Call system. Incumbent duties may include assignment with monitoring of private sector individuals as needed; assures nursing care programs are carried out thoroughly. May be required to provide nursing services to comply with CLA regulations. Provides nursing input to inter-disciplinary health care plans. Works with the IFS team providing medical information and attend meetings and make reports on health status. This position will report to the Nurse Consultant. Performs other duties as required.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of nursing principles and clinical therapeutic models of patient and/or consumer care with emphasis on interdisciplinary team approaches as related to individuals with developmental disabilities. Knowledge of individual treatment planning including impact of medical insurance program requirements for reimbursement; knowledge of structure of services for consumers and their families in institutional and community oriented settings as related to individuals with developmental disabilities; knowledge of aftercare facilities; considerable interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills.

General Experience: Three (3) years of professional nursing experience.

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been at the level of Head Nurse working with individuals with developmental disabilities. Department of Development Services (General): One (1) year of the General Experience must have been providing consultation and evaluating the assessment of nursing services provided to individuals with intellectual disabilities.

Substitutions Allowed:

1. A Bachelor's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of the General Experience.
2. A Master's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirements:

1. Incumbent must possess and retain in good standing a license to practice Registered Professional Nursing in the State of Connecticut.
2. Incumbent must possess and retain a valid Driver's license.
3. Incumbent will be required to travel.
4. Incumbent must be willing to work flexible hours including nights, weekends and holidays as needed to meet agency needs.
