**General Experience:**

A minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Engineering is required. Civil, Environmental, or Sanitary Engineering is preferred. Bachelor's degree in Chemical or Mechanical Engineering will also be considered.

**Description of Duties:**

The incumbent will perform a wide variety of increasingly difficult duties as technical skills are acquired during course of training period. These duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting in the review of planning, design and construction documents of municipal wastewater infrastructure projects,
- Assisting in determining compliance with the regulatory requirements of the Clean Water Fund,
- Assisting in the drafting of discharge permits for wastewater treatment facilities,
- Assisting in review of wastewater discharge permit applications,
- Assisting in the evaluation and development of enforcement actions,
- Basic evaluation of sources and remediation of water pollution.

**Preferred Candidate must have:**

- General knowledge of basic civil, chemical, or mechanical engineering theories and principles, with emphasis in environmental, construction, or sanitary engineering.
- Training/Knowledge to analyze, interpret, and evaluate engineering issues and prepare technical reports.
- Good project management skills and the ability to prioritize and track multiple tasks.
- Training/knowledge in written and oral communication and interpersonal skills to address and confer effectively with peers, public officials and the general public.
- Training/knowledge in computer software, including proficiency with Microsoft Office.

**Special Requirement:**

Incumbent will receive one to two years training in introductory professional engineering work for the development of technical and professional engineering skills and knowledge in order to qualify for advancement to the technical engineering work level (Sanitary Engineer 1).
