Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must have applied for and passed the **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYST 1** exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take and qualify with the Environmental Analyst 1 exam currently offered before the closing date for this position. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Candidates for the Environmental Intern level must have a Bachelor's or Master's degree in a scientific or technical discipline related to the environmental field.

Description of Duties:

This position will be responsible for assisting with collection of environmental data and technical review and analysis of environmental data, reports, and documents as required by the Federal Clean Water Act. Within the context of assessing and evaluating water quality conditions and related impacts, duties will include assisting with:

- Research, collection, and analysis of water quality related resource data;
- Conduct of site investigations and conditions;
- Assessment of impacts to exposed human and ecological populations;
- Preparation of recommended actions or alternatives to mitigate potential impacts;
- Technical consultations with various public and governmental officials;
- Preparation of data summaries, publications, and policies.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

The preferred candidate will have experience or training in:

1. Biological or physical sciences, including environmental science, environmental geography, and/or biology;
2. Principles and practices of Geographic Information Systems, including ArcMap 9 or 10;
3. Coordinating effectively, work cooperatively, and contribute well in a team environment;
4. Evaluating and interpreting environmental data, determine potential environmental impact, and develop recommended actions;

5. State and federal water quality laws and pollution control programs, including the Federal Clean Water Act, , and Water Quality Standards;
6. Collecting and analyzing field data pertaining to the assessment of environmental conditions and health of ecological populations;
7. Software applications, including those designed to predict and analyze statistics and environmental data, including MS EXCEL, ACCESS, WORD, and PowerPoint, Minitab.;
8. Interpersonal, oral and written communication, and critical analysis skills, including writing technical reports and giving public presentations.

Special Requirement:

The incumbent may be exposed to some danger of injury or physical harm from onsite environments and a moderate degree of discomfort from exposure to year round weather conditions.
