ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS Candidates must be on the current DAS exam list for ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE SPECIALIST 2 or ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE SPECIALIST 1 OR have attained permanent status in one of the two job classifications. The incumbent will be required to possess and maintain a current drivers' license.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES This Municipal Facilities' ECS 2 will be responsible for independently performing a full range of tasks in the inspection, monitoring, and evaluation of municipal and private wastewater treatment facilities, including the duties below. An ECS 1 will assist with the duties:

- inspect municipal and private wastewater treatment facilities, operations, and equipment to identify or evaluate malfunctions or non-compliance;
- review applicable procedures and test plans to ensure completeness and accuracy and review documents and contracts for compliance;
- observe operating conditions and sampling of effluents by manual and instrumental methods;
- monitor test equipment performance and verifying the adequacy of sampling and monitoring conducted;
- review and evaluate reports that may include testing results and data analyses to determine facility compliance;
- perform routine mathematical computations and analysis;
- participate in enforcement activities to obtain compliance with permits and regulations;
- recommend corrective action and draft of notices of violation;
- may issue field citations, conduct follow-up enforcement activities to monitor compliance, and monitor or direct clean-up operations by contractors;
- investigate and respond to complaints;
- respond to incidents on sites;
- participate in training of lower level staff as assigned; prepare correspondence, investigative reports, enforcement reports and documents;
- may attend hearing or testify in court and may confer with representative of facilities, consultants, municipal and state official

WORKING CONDITIONS Frequent travel within the state will be required and the incumbent may be exposed to some danger of injury or physical harm from onsite environments and a moderate degree of discomfort from exposure to year round weather conditions.

PREFERRED CRITERIA

The preferred candidate will have knowledge of and experience with sewage treatment plant operations and with various methods of sample collection; experience in environmental investigations and inspections; demonstrated written and oral communication and interpersonal skills; and the ability to read and interpret permits, guidance manuals and regulations related to water pollution control.
