The Hammonasset Beach State Park unit consists primarily of Hammonasset Beach State Park & Campground, but also includes Meigs Point Nature Center, 2-1/2 miles of beach shoreline, some of which has lifeguards, 4 day use toilet buildings, a campground with 554 campsites, 8 cabins, 18 toilet buildings with showers, 5 boat launches, 10 wildlife management areas and a natural area preserve.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES Responsible for independently performing a full range of maintenance and moderately skilled trade tasks on the lands and facilities and may assist in supervising seasonal employees and Maintainers of lower grade. Duties will include: moderately skilled carpentry, masonry, painting, simple plumbing tasks and minor electrical repairs; general maintenance on lands, buildings, dams and other facilities and road and trail maintenance; use, maintenance, and repair of hand and power tools and equipment such as saws, axes, cant hooks, mowing equipment, tractors, trucks, boats and related equipment; planting, transplanting, cutting and pruning; assisting in liberating wildlife; interaction with the public for information and assistance; work with blueprints and specifications; design and construction of educational exhibits; care for and maintenance of aquatic and terrestrial live animal exhibits and may interpret same (educational) exhibits for the public; conducting public outreach programs and events; fire patrol and fire fighting activities, use and maintenance of firefighting equipment, leading and training a small seasonal crew or group of firefighters; coordination and leading volunteer activities; clerical duties of very limited duration; and other duties as required.

WORKING CONDITIONS Will be exposed to year-round weather conditions and will be required to work in uncomfortable conditions. May be exposed to some danger of injury working under varying weather conditions, lifting moderate weights, handling chemical solutions and live animals, operating various types of equipment and vehicles, and other job-related tasks; and may be required to work weekends and/or holidays. May be included in the biennial statewide shift and location bidding process, per the NP-5 union contract.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Physical Requirements Must be in good health and must have and retain sufficient physical strength, stamina, agility, visual and auditory acuity to effectively perform the duties of the job.

General Experience Must have at least one (1) year of experience in maintenance and repair work outlined in the Duties above.

Substitution allowed: Graduation from a secondary school with specialization in a trade pertinent to the operation, maintenance, and development of natural resources may be substituted for the General Experience.

Special Requirements May be required to acquire, within six months of notification, and maintain: a Class A Commercial Driver License (CDL); Standard First Aid and CPR certificates; licenses and/or certifications as required by Federal and State laws and regulations for the operation of heavy equipment; and/or appropriate current licenses and/or certifications as required by a particular trade.

Preferred Criteria The preferred candidate will have good interpersonal skills and the ability to work well with the public; a current driver's license; experience with plumbing, electrical and carpentry work; experience with small engine, equipment, and vehicle repair and maintenance; experience operating large tractors and equipment, including snow plowing and beach raking; experience leading work crews of maintainers; experience working with live animals and constructing exhibits; and park interpretive skills.
