The Squantz Pond park unit consists primarily of Squantz Pond State Park, but also includes Lovers Leap State Park and Pootatuck State Forest. The park unit is open year round and offers swimming, boating, hiking, and picnicking. Facilities include day use toilet buildings, 3 boat launches, and 1 wildlife management area.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES This EP Maintainer 2 will be responsible for independently performing a full range of maintenance and moderately skilled trade tasks on the lands and facilities and leading seasonal employees. Duties will include moderately skilled carpentry, masonry, painting, simple plumbing tasks and minor electrical repairs; general maintenance on lands, buildings, and other facilities and road and trail maintenance; the use, maintenance, and repair of hand and power tools and equipment such as saws, axes, cant hooks, mowing equipment, tractors, trucks, boats and related equipment; planting, transplanting, cutting and pruning; work with blueprints and specifications; fire patrol and fire fighting activities, including the use and maintenance of firefighting equipment; clerical duties of very limited duration; and other related duties as required.

WORKING CONDITIONS The EP Maintainer 2 will be exposed to year-round weather conditions, will be required to work in uncomfortable conditions, and may be exposed to some danger of injury while working under varying weather conditions, lifting moderate weights, handling chemical solutions, operating various types of equipment and vehicles, and other job-related tasks; and may be required to work weekends and/or holidays. EP Maintainers may be required to change locations due to the biennial statewide shift and location bidding process.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

General Experience Must have at least one (1) year of experience in maintenance and repair work outlined in the Duties above.

Substitution allowed: Graduation from a secondary school with specialization in a trade pertinent to the operation, maintenance, and development of natural resources may be substituted for the General Experience.

Physical Requirements Must be in good health and must have and retain sufficient physical strength, stamina, agility, visual and auditory acuity to effectively perform the duties of the job.

Special Requirements May be required to acquire, within six months of notification, and maintain: a Class A Commercial Driver License (CDL); Standard First Aid and CPR certificates; licenses and/or certifications as required by Federal and State laws and regulations for the operation of heavy equipment; and/or appropriate current licenses and/or certifications as required by a particular trade.

PREFERRED CRITERIA The preferred candidate will have good interpersonal skills and the ability to work well with the public; a current driver's license; experience with plumbing, electrical and carpentry work; experience with small engine, equipment, and vehicle repair and maintenance; operation of equipment including snow plowing and large tractors; experience leading and supervising work crews.
