Eligibility Requirement: Candidates on Reemployment/SEBAC lists will be given first consideration.

Description of Duties:

- Perform highly skilled tasks on DEEP plumbing and heating systems, gas, water, steam and sewer disposal systems
- Maintenance and repairs to public restroom facilities include valve, fixture, piping, flush-o-meter, fixture and sewer line repair/ replacement
- Conduct annual winterization and startups of seasonal buildings
- Perform public water system testing and other required repaired to meet DPH standards
- Installation, maintenance and repair to oil and gas burners and associated equipment

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Excellent knowledge of standard plumbing and heating trade practices including materials, operation, equipments and repair methods
- Must have a P-1(plumbing) and S-1 (heating) licenses
- Good interpersonal, oral and written communication skills
- Basic computer and estimating skills
- Good records keeping experience

General Experience:

Four (4) years of experience in plumbing and heating.

Special Experience:

Two (2) years of general experience as a P-1 and/or S-1 license holder performing skilled trade functions.

Substitutions Allowed:

- 1) Graduation from a vocational or technical school with a diploma designating completion of subject requirements in a maintenance trade area may be substituted for two (2) years of the general experience.
- 2) Two (2) years of experience as a Qualified Craft Worker Intern may be substituted for the General and Special Experience.

Special Requirement:

- Incumbents in this class will be required to retain an unlimited contractor's license (P-1, S-1)
- Incumbents in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility and visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties. A physical examination may be required
- Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate to heavy weight and may be exposed to extreme weather conditions and to risk of injury from equipment
- Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain specific education and/or experience to meet various certification requirements
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- Required to use appropriate protective equipment such as respirators and safety goggles
- Incumbent in this class may be required to travel
