**Duties may include but not limited to:** The DMHAS Behavioral Health Clinical Manager is responsible for coordinating SWCMHS' services with the larger community; overseeing and coordinating with DMHAS contracted PNP agencies in Region 1; working with PNP leadership to assure compliance with expectations and to address operational issues and interface with DMHAS services; overseeing the Shelter Plus Care, the Housing Waiting List and PNP auditing processes; overseeing the Care Management Team which provides clinical services to clients concurrently active with the PNPs; developing other community resources, reviewing system functioning and interagency collaborations, and developing proposals for necessary changes; working with CVH liaison and GBCMHC Inpatient Director to facilitate placement of hospitalized clients in community residential programs; if necessary, in collaboration with the PNPs, develop contracts and/or contract amendments around special services necessary for the discharge of challenging clients; perform other duties as required.

**General Experience and Training:** Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

**Special Experience:** Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff. For state employees, this is at the level of Behavioral Health Unit Supervisor; Nurse Supervisor or Supervising Clinician.

**Special Requirement:** Incumbents in this class must maintain the appropriate current license for clinical social work, marital and family therapist, professional counselor, registered nurse or clinical psychologist. Must possess, retain and carry a valid Connecticut driver's license as travel in the community is required.

**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

**Note:** Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
