Duties may include but not limited to: This position requires specialized clinical knowledge and skill to provide supervision, leadership and direction to a multi-disciplinary team. The team is designed to provide state of the art, trauma-sensitive clinical services to young adults with complex and challenging mental health conditions. This position will also provide a full array of sophisticated clinical interventions including: DBT, TREM, the Janina Fisher Model, Seeking Safety and IDDT. Duties include: clinical supervision, evaluation of employee performance, training and staff development, individual and group therapy, clinical assessment, crisis intervention, life skills development, recovery planning and family support and close monitoring of clinical outcomes. This position will also provide evening and weekend administrative on call coverage to provide clinical consultation and direction related to risk issues, clinical needs, staffing issues, critical incidents and overall program needs. This position may require evening and weekend hours depending on clinical needs of the program.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

General Experience: Seven (7) years of professional health care experience in a psychiatric setting.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at a lead level responsible for coordinating the work of a unit or team of professionals in a psychiatric setting.

Note: For State Employees the lead level is interpreted at the level of a Clinical Social Worker Associate for social work discipline, Head Nurse for the nursing discipline, an Associate Professional Counselor and an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be required to lift and restrain clients, may have significant exposure to communicable and/or infectious diseases and risk of injury and may be exposed to strongly disagreeable conditions.
