General Experience: Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements:

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Duties: : This position provides clinical, rehabilitative, and recovery services to a large number of clients living in our community on a Community Support Program [CSP] composed of a team of multidisciplinary staff. The CSP program is an evidence based model of community care for clients with a severe and persistent mental illness and/or substance use disorder. The core components of this model are working with clients to gain or improve skills for successful living in the community, an improved quality of life, greater independence to pursue their goals through the values of recovery. This position includes providing clinical assessments, individual, group and family psychotherapy, field work, use of psychosocial assessments, clinical formulations, diagnostic evaluations, etc. Work with clients and team members in the development of individualized Recovery Plans and supporting documentation. Attain and maintain necessary productivity standards, regular use of electronic health record, work with CSP team in reaching fidelity measures for CSP model. Assist and/or direct psychoeducational programming, and psychosocial rehabilitative services. Monitoring risk management, and working collaboratively with jail diversion program. May lead facility or community based committees that are involved in the care, treatment and advocacy for our psychiatrically disabled clientele.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
