Duties include: Designs and develops programs and activities including development of program performance standards and criteria; implements new procedures and procedural revisions; directs and administers staff and operations of multiple functions related to Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS) which includes Older Adult Services, Mental Health Waiver, ABI-TBI Programs, 60 West, Nursing Home Diversion and other re-balancing efforts. Coordinates, plans and manages activities; oversees units/staff administering DMHAS program mandates; ensures conformance with agency mission, goals, objectives and statutory provisions; develops or assists in development and implementation of related policy; interprets and administers pertinent laws; evaluates staff; prepares or assists in preparation of division budget; maintains contacts with individuals both within and outside of division who might impact on program activities; ensures agency compliance with standards established by outside monitoring agencies; directs recruitment, selection and retention of department or discipline staff; ensures compliance with quality assurance findings and recommendations; promotes cultural diversity in workplace and ensures client rights; identifies, plans, implements and evaluates staff training and development needs; analyzes complex problems and takes appropriate action; initiates workforce planning and monitors staff utilization to meet identified goals; investigates and responds to critical incidents; prepares or oversees preparation of reports; may represent facility in grievances and hearings; oversees grant, budget and contract preparation for both general and federal funds; conducts clinical supervision with multiple clinicians throughout the organization; oversees compliance with the nursing home litigation and acts as a liaison with the Office of the Attorney General and the Private non-profit organization, clinicians and patients; insures all qualifying patients are given appropriate rights under the clinical requirements of the litigation settlement; all performs other duties as required.

General Experience:

Six (6) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health care and a Master's Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

Special Experience:

Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at a managerial capacity directing clinical operations or the delivery of behavioral health care services. This includes the supervision of professional behavioral health care staff. For State Employees, this is at the level of Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services Behavioral Health Clinical Manager.

Note: Managerial experience is defined as formulating program goals and objectives, developing and implementing program procedures, initiating program policies and developing and/or monitoring a budget.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must maintain the appropriate current license for clinical social worker, marital and family therapist, professional counselor, psychologist, or nurse practitioner/clinical nurse specialist. Incumbent will be required to travel and must have a valid motor vehicle operator's license.
