**Special Requirements:**

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

**Duties:** Provides clinical oversight and treatment support to clients residing in the Young Adult Transitional Housing Program. Ability to lead and provide clinical direction and support to paraprofessional staff. Participates as a member of a multi-disciplinary treatment team. Responsible for development of recovery plans for young adults residing at program in collaboration with clinical team. Provides shift oversight of the implementation of behavioral programming and skill building modules. Ability to coordinate responsive intervention and support to client in crisis. Documents client's progress in the medical record. Motivates and supports clients in their Recovery, while assisting them to establish a natural support system. Has knowledge of development stages relevant to young adult's age 18-25 years. Must have knowledge and strong understanding of trauma informed practices.
