Duties may include but not limited to: The duties of this position include but are not limited to: Act as a clinical social worker associate on an interdisciplinary clinical team specializing in community mental health treatment and rehabilitation. Responsibilities include carrying a clinical caseload providing diagnosis, psychosocial assessments, recovery planning, referral, crisis intervention, individual and group psychotherapy and outreach. In addition primary supervision of staff in lower classifications including professional staff is required. Collaboration with other DMHAS units and non-DMHAS providers is required. The LCSWA will participate in organizational committees and trainings as directed and other related duties as required.

General Experience: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess, retain, and carry valid Connecticut Drivers License. Travel in the community is required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, state employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside state service.

Application Instructions: **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Clinical Social Worker Associate applying to a Clinical Social Worker Associate posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12). **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application. All applicants must submit three (3) letters of supervisory reference, a copy of any license or certification and their two most recent performance appraisals.
