Eligibility Requirement:

Candidates must have applied for and passed the **Behavioral Health Program Manager** exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

Duties include but are not limited to: facilitate the development and implementation of appropriately designed multicultural training institutes and programs that execute the Department's policies related to the provision of culturally competent behavioral health services and supports; facilitate and manage initiatives to reduce healthcare disparities and ensure access to treatment and services for un-served and underserved populations; participate in the development and revision of policies related to the provision of culturally competent services as a pillar of the DMHAS recovery-oriented system; facilitate the development and implementation of training institutes and programs to develop awareness of DMHAS policies requiring delivery of culturally competent behavioral health services; facilitate the development and implementation of initiatives and programs to implement DMHAS' multicultural strategic plan; ensure quality-of-care management systems that monitor cultural competence as an integral part of defined service outcomes.

Special Requirements: Incumbent will be required to travel and must possess current motor vehicle operator's license and reliable transportation.

Qualified candidates with experience delivering or managing culturally competent services are encouraged to apply.
