General Experience: Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements:

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Duties: Provide clinical and case management services to young adults who are clinically complex and living in the community. Clients in this program struggle with psychotic disorders, mood disorders, PTSD, substance abuse, autism spectrum disorders, and may be medically fragile. Responsible for intake, assessment and ongoing evaluation of clients recovery and discharge planning. Provide individual, group and family treatment, and education. Participate in and coordinate all treaters' meetings, case conferences, critical incident reviews and other meetings as indicated. Ability to work as a member of a multidisciplinary team, perform risk assessments, and possess computer technology skills. Demonstrate the ability to make appropriate and timely referrals, build relationships with service providers.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
