DUTIES: Collaborates with the Intake Clinician in the assessment and triage of assigned new Young Adult Services clients for appropriateness of Psychiatric and Behavioral Health Services at the Torrington Area Office of the Western Connecticut Mental Health Network; collaborates with Intake Clinician in performing Risk Assessment on assigned new Young Adult Services clients admitted to the Torrington Area Office of WCMHN; collaborates with the Intake Clinician in the development of the Initial Recovery Plan of all assigned newly-admitted clients. Provides evaluation & management services to assigned outpatient caseload; oversees the preparation and content of recovery plans of assigned clients; performs emergency Psychiatric evaluations on existing clients when needed; participates in case conferences, critical incident reviews, and other appropriate clinical meetings when needed; provides liaison services to assigned clients who are hospitalized when needed; provides Probate Court testimony regarding conservatorship/other legal matters for assigned clients when needed. Participates in network-wide, off site physician on-call rotation as scheduled by the Medical Director.

State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

For Principal Psychiatrist: General Experience: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or board certification in Adult or Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f). Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain certification as a specialist in an area such as geriatrics, ABI/TBI, forensics, substance abuse, etc. Incumbents in this class may be required to possess appropriate current licenses, certifications or permits. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

For Staff Psychiatrist: General Experience: Graduation from an Accredited Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) psychiatric residency program. **Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Incumbents in this class must obtain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology within five years of appointment to this class OR demonstrate continued competency and proficiency in the practice of psychiatry by successfully completing an established agency program. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f). Incumbents in this class may be required to possess appropriate current licenses, certifications or permits. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

3. **All Other Candidates:** Individuals must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
