**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status and candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

**Duties may include but not limited to:** As a member of the Mobile Outreach Team, the CSWA will Independently provide highly skilled direct clinical social work treatment and/or substance abuse services to clients in crisis with complex psychological and social problems through comprehensive clinical assessments; provide clinical and/or administrative supervision to employees and regularly function in the role of shift leader. Provide crisis assessments and interventions including risk management, conduct intakes for referral to treatment and other community behavioral health services, follow-up contact to ensure that individuals follow through with referred services, maintain documentation on each individual served, enhance communication across the local behavioral health system of care including Forensics, law enforcement, and criminal justice systems. Promote linkages and resource utilization with the above. Provide emergency certification to transport clients for assessment and intervention at emergency rooms. Educate local providers on the dynamics of behavioral health problems, homelessness, high-risk, high-needs of the clients served and the behavioral health network/system. Provide direct clinical care in a wide variety of community settings, including face to face assessments in the community and criminal justice settings. Will be required to utilize electronic health records. Other duties as assigned.

**General Experience and Training:** One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

**Note:** Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
