Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status and candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Duties may include but not limited to: Provide an array of clinical services and interventions to clients and citizens in our catchment area; including intakes for clients referred to our agency and input information into the electronic health record, clinical assessments, crisis assessments/interventions at the agency and in the community; working collaboratively with teams, law enforcement, hospitals and other agencies that provide services to clients we serve/support; answer crisis lines and make quick appropriate decisions of the needed intervention; documenting and writing clinical reports, provide excellent customer service in all interactions with others; communicate and follow up on client care; writing Emergency Certificates in the community; will work with clients in their apartments/homes for further stabilization, to assess, etc.; provide suggestions to support staff in creating crisis plans, to assist in hospital dispositions and discharge planning from hospitals, or other clinical programs; perform other related duties as required.

Experience and Training: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

Note: Non-Examined refers to Section 5-219 of the Connecticut General Statutes which permits appointment of candidates to competitive positions without formal examination when a professional license, professional degree, accreditation or certificate is a mandatory requirement for appointment to a class.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
