Duties may include but not limited to: The clinical social worker will serve on an interdisciplinary clinical team specializing in community mental health treatment and rehabilitation; Responsibilities include diagnosis, psychosocial assessments, recovery planning, referral, crisis intervention, individual and group psychotherapy and outreach; Collaboration with other DMHAS units and non-DMHAS providers; Will participate in organizational committees and trainings as directed and perform other related duties as required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

General Experience and Training: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in the class must possess, retain, and carry valid Motor Vehicle Operators License. Travel in the community is required.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be exposed to some risk of injury from assaultive and/or abusive clients.
