**Eligibility Requirement:**

Candidates must have applied for and passed the Police Lieutenant exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

**Duties may include but not limited to:** consistent with the State of CT Job Specification. The Police Lieutenant assigned to the Division of Safety Services, Support Operations receives assignments from the MH Director of Safety and Security Management (Chief) and the MH Asst. Director of Safety and Security Management (Deputy Chief).

The Police Lieutenant supervises the Support Operations Unit within the Public Safety Division as follows: Plans, organizes, assigns, supervises and evaluates the staff responsible for investigative support services and activities; plans, organizes, assigns, supervises and evaluates the staff responsible for information and records management, support services and activities involved in systems management, information and records maintenance, quality control and security of computerized data information systems used by the Public Safety Division including NEXGEN System, NCIC/COLLECT System and DMHAS Gun Control System; plans, organizes, assigns, supervises and participates in recruitment, screening, selection and promotional initiatives and activities..

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Candidates for this class are subject to selection standards pursuant to Section 7-294-a-e of the Connecticut General Statutes and the regulations of the Connecticut Police Officer Standards and Training Council.
2. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain authority from the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection to "arrest and present before a competent authority any person for any offense committed within his precinct." (Connecticut General Statutes 29-18 and/or 10a-142).
3. Incumbents must possess and maintain certification as a law enforcement officer in the State of Connecticut pursuant to Section 7-294-a-e of the Connecticut General Statutes and the regulations promulgated by the Connecticut Police Officer Standards and Training Council. Loss of certification will result in removal from the class.
4. Incumbents in this class may be required to maintain certifications pursuant to the regulations of the Connecticut Police Officer Standards and Training Council and/or agency requirements.
5. Incumbents in this class will be required to travel and must possess and maintain a valid Motor Vehicle Operator's license.
6. Incumbents in this class must be eligible and qualified to bear arms.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
