**Duties may include but not limited to:** Uses the nursing process for the assessment, evaluation and treatment of all patients. Implements all MD orders ensuring patients' safety and quality of care; reports changes in patients condition to the appropriate discipline to ensure all medical and psychiatric needs of the patient are addressed; formulates a plan of care that will meet the individual needs of the patient; utilizes effective therapeutic interventions to facilitate achievement of the highest level of functioning in patients' activities of daily living; demonstrates collaboration with nursing and interdisciplinary staff; accurately assesses and documents patient's response to pain interventions; fosters a cooperative working relationship among staff members of all disciplines; effectively assumes charge responsibilities when designated; evaluates and prescribes nursing treatment in crisis situation; makes effective decisions and evaluates the results of action taken; ensures safekeeping of medications and their accurate preparation and administration; arranges medical appointments; facilitates groups; documents patients group participation in the medical record; maintains a safe therapeutic environment at all times; participates, when needed, in the restraining and monitoring of any patient who requires such intervention; ensures compliance with JCAHO and Medicare standards of nursing practice; performs other related duties as assigned.

**General Experience:** Graduation from an accredited nursing program.

**Special Requirement:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license or temporary permit as a Registered Professional Nurse in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

**Working Conditions:** Incumbents in this class may be required to lift and restrain patients/clients; may have exposure to communicable/infectious diseases and risk of injury from assaultive/abusive patients/clients; may be exposed to disagreeable conditions.
