Duties may include but not limited to: Reports to the Medical Director and serves as the medical director in their absence; supervises the inpatient medical staff, including the doctors who cover evenings, weekends and holidays; oversees the clinical care on the inpatient units and consults on difficult cases; coordinates the consultations of our expert psychopharmacologist to assure state-of-the-art pharmacological management; coordinates clinical conferences in inpatient service and helps coordinate any case conferences with DMHAS medical director; assures that the inpatient services are compliant with the standards of the Joint Commission; works collaboratively with the Director of Hospital Services who is administratively in charge of the inpatient units; participates in the Community Hospital Services Division leadership group; participates as an ex-officio member of the Medical Staff Executive Committee; works collaboratively with HR and Labor Relations in dealing with issues in the workplace; works collaboratively with CLRP to assure compliance with the CT statutes and respect for patient rights; fosters culturally-competent patient care; serves as co-chair of the P&T committee; serves on other committees as necessary; performs other duties as required.

General Experience: Five (5) years of experience in a hospital, clinic or correctional facility as a staff psychiatrist.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f). Must possess, retain, and carry valid Motor Vehicle Driver's License. Travel in the community is required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
