Duties may include but not limited to: Provides comprehensive clinical assessments, risk assessments and medication management services to adults seen on an outpatient basis with severe and persistent mental illness and co-occurring substance use disorders. Functions as a co-leader of the treatment team and provides reviews of recovery plans, clinical records and discharge plans for adherence to policies and Joint Commission standards; provides all services in a recovery-oriented manner. Assesses, examines, diagnoses and prescribes appropriate medications and other biologic and psychosocial treatments to a caseload of about 120-150 adults, coordinates with primary and specialty care providers, as needed, and performs advanced level risk assessments; consults on difficult and/or complex cases. Additionally, this position may conduct comprehensive outpatient clinical intakes in conjunction with the intake department.

The Inpatient Treatment Unit is a sixteen bed inpatient care unit which operates seven days a week, 24 hours a day. The major function of the program is to provide inpatient services to people from the CRMHC service area with a focus on those who are uninsured, who cannot obtain services from other providers, and are served by CRMHC. This program provides a broad range of services including medication management, individual and group therapy, occupational therapy, and recreational interventions. The average length of stay in this program is about 180 days.

Special Requirements - Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f). Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain certification as a specialist in an area such as geriatrics, ABI/TBI, forensics, substance abuse, etc. Incumbents in this class may be required to possess appropriate current licenses, certifications or permits. Must possess and retain a current valid Connecticut Motor Vehicle Operator License.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Head Nurse applying to a Head Nurse posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
