**Duties include:** Establishes and monitors budget; develops contracts with NFP agencies for prevention, intervention, treatment, program evaluation and research services in each of the state's five human services regions; oversees specialized training and supervision of regional providers; functions as the primary contact between DMHAS and other gambling related state agencies such as the Division of Special Revenue and the CT Lottery Corporation; represents DMHAS in state-wide stake holder activities including the Partnership for Responsible Gambling; co-ordinates state-wide advocacy activities on behalf of problem gamblers and families, Develops treatment protocols based on emerging best practices; monitors the functioning of the state-wide Problem Gambling Helpline; oversees state-wide professional education and training; in collaboration with DMHAS director of communications, serves as state-wide representative of Problem Gambling Services to the press and other media. Conducts outreach to agencies, organizations and state departments; develops and monitors problem gambling prevention contracts, activities and programs; develops print, video and audio materials including reports, pamphlets, booklets, posters and training materials for state-wide distribution; provides consultation on problem gambling, as requested, to all branches of government. represents DMHAS at national and regional conferences and in national organizations such as the Association of Problem Gambling Services Administrators.

**Preferred Candidate:** Must be certified as a Board Approved Clinical Consultant (BACC) which is the supervisory designation for the National Gambling Counselor Certification Board and for the CT Certification Board (CCB).

**General Experience:**

Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

**Special Experience:**

Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff.

For state employees, this is at the level of Behavioral Health Unit Supervisor; Nurse Supervisor or Supervising Clinician.

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must maintain the appropriate current license for, clinical social worker, marital and family therapist, professional counselor, registered nurse, clinical psychologist or alcohol and drug counselor.
