**Duties include:** Responsible for planning healthcare services for broad segments of the population, including the means by which services can be financed; evaluating new technologies; implementing regulations and assessing their impact and for preparing reports for other governmental entities including the legislature, as well as specifically recommending courses of action; oversees the monitoring of the OPA lawsuit settlement in collaboration with the court appointed monitor; oversees the administrative functions of the Mental Health Waiver including budgets, resources and outcomes to ensure compliance with federal Waiver Assurances and requirements of CMS; liaison with DSS and ASCEND regarding PASSR, legislators regarding compliance and assurances; coordinates and facilitates bi-monthly meetings with ABH and DSS; participates in quarterly budget meetings; ensures that Statewide Services Programs particularly the Home and Community Based Transition Programs and Mental Health Waiver Programs operate in accordance with the approved design of the programs, meets statutory and regulatory assurances and requirements, achieves desired outcomes and identifies opportunities for improvement; coordinates collection of data for all transition programs; interprets the data and recommends quality improvement; interprets and facilitates resources pertaining to the Home and Community Based Transition Programs, Mental Health Waiver, OPA lawsuit and Money Follows the Person, prepares or oversees the preparation of applications, reports and responses representing DMHAS for the Statewide Waiver Services; performs related duties as required.

**General Experience:**

Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

**Special Experience:**

Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff.
