**Duties may include but not limited to:** Serves as a senior member of the MCT team. The CSWA is responsible for the following duties: provides clinical and administrative management and supervision for 2nd/3rd shift MCT/Respite staff; Conducts crisis assessments, both on-site and in the field at a variety of community locations. Attend to the safety of clients and staff in all MCT interventions. Respond to crisis telephone calls. Participate in the development of high-risk intervention plans. Participate in team problem-solving. Participate in the development of MCT treatment plans with staff, clients and available collateral individuals. Implement an individualized MCT treatment plan. Conduct follow-up monitoring of the client through In reach or field visits to assess level of stability and degree of participation in the treatment plan. Provide supportive counseling as needed to clients and family. Under supervision, perform toxicology screens both at RVS and in the field.

**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.
