Duties include but are not limited to: Review referrals from Jail Diversion, Judges, Probation Officers, Department of Corrections and AIC staff to determine appropriateness for the ASIST program. Conduct screenings and in-depth clinical evaluations for all ASIST referrals. Complete Level of Service Inventory-Revised (LSI-R) assessments to determine level of criminogenic needs. Recommends treatment options to the referring agent based on the assessment of the client, conditions set by the court, and available treatment providers in the community. Manage a high acuity case load of 45 clients with complex and challenging conditions and provide brief treatment, crisis intervention, case management and supervision. Collaborate with AIC staff in addressing criminogenic needs as well as serving as a role model to AIC staff related to working with clinically complex clients and circumstances. Provide written reports to the referral source regarding client's compliance with treatment, compliance with ASIST treatment goals and changes in the client's treatment status. Act as a liaison between community agencies and the Department of Corrections to ensure continuity of treatment upon admission to ASIST. May be required to perform other tasks and duties as indicated.

General Experience and Training: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess, retain and carry a valid Connecticut Drivers License. Travel in the community is required.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
