Duties may include but not limited to: Utilizes therapeutic interventions to facilitate achievement of the highest level of functioning of Activities of Daily Living; Participates as an active member of the clinical treatment team; Welcomes and orients new staff members to the unit by reinforcing skills learned in orientation; Assists other staff in direct patient care: Accurately records patient census; Monitors patients for contraband, and personal items which could be used to compromise unit security and/or inflict self-harm, and conducts searches as needed; Reports patterns, changes or conditions in patient behavior and affect to charge staff; Consistently and actively supports Patients Rights and patient empowerment; Respects and acknowledges patients' cultural identity and needs (i.e., dress, food, language and values); Attends in-service education/training; Performs other related duties as assigned

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Candidates must have **applied for and passed** the **FORENSIC TREATMENT SPECIALIST** exam and **be on the current certification list** promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification by **January 17, 2017**.
2. State employees currently holding the above title or State employees who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.
3. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Forensic Treatment Specialist applying to a Forensic Treatment Specialist posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.
