Duties may include but not limited to: The LPN assists doctors and works under the supervision of a Registered Nurse in providing general care and treatment of patients; measures doses and administers medications including insulin injections; documents medications using appropriate forms; performs narcotic counts; checks and may administer intravenous medications; reports changes in patients to doctors; ensures that restraints are applied correctly; transcribes doctors medication orders; dispenses certain medications in doctors absence; applies topical medication; takes and charts temperatures, pulses and respirations; performs simple nursing treatments; monitors general patient needs including personal hygiene; reports on patient conditions and behavior; keeps the unit safe and healthy; administers enemas or suppositories; performs Foley catheterization care; orients patients concerning medications and their use; may perform emergency first aid; performs related duties as required.

Uses principles of adult learning that are appropriate to the patient's age and clinical condition to implement health teaching for patient and family in areas identified as needs on Initial Nursing Assessment and in ongoing nursing assessment. May conduct inpatient groups, such as community meetings, orientation sessions, healthy living groups and medication education. Participates in revising the individualized NCP in collaboration with the Registered Nurse. Demonstrates interviewing skills that allow for the correcting of data and the interaction of the nurse-patient relationship.

Identifies risk factors including risk of self-injury and/or injury to others, AWOL risk and potential or actual substance withdrawal or medical instability. Utilizes the NCP/MTP to identify patient goals for assigned patients Promotes self-care activities for identified deficits in ADL's on a continuous basis and throughout hospitalization and performs other related duties.

General Experience and Training: License or temporary permit to practice nursing in Connecticut by the State Board of Examiners for Nursing

Special Requirement: Must possess retain and carry a valid Connecticut Drivers License. Travel in the community is required. **Bilingual Spanish speaking required**

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions: Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the Position Number (found on the posting) on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (upper right-hand corner) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12)

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: CSW applying to a CSW posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
