Duties may include but not limited to: Functions as the Program Director of the Mobile Crisis Team and Intake Unit; direct supervisor of all Mobile Crisis and intake staff; oversees daily and ongoing operations of the program. Ensures that all agency policies and procedures are adhered to; oversees scheduling, performance appraisals, and daily assignments of duties and responsibilities; functions as a member of the leadership team of the Acute Services Division and the clinical services division; oversees the Critical Incident Stress Management Team; may provide direct care as needed; perform other related duties as assigned.

General Experience: Six (6) years of experience as a professional nurse.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at or above the level of Nurse Clinician in a psychiatric setting performing individual, group and/or family therapy.

Substitution Allowed: 1) A Bachelor's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of the General Experience. 2) Master's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirements: **1)** Must possess and retain a current license as a registered professional nurse in Connecticut. **2)** Must possess, retain and carry a valid Connecticut Driver's License. **3)** Travel in the community is required. **4)** Incumbents in this class who write medications must have a current license as an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse issued by the Department of Health.
