Duties may include but not limited to: Coordinates and leads therapeutic recreation groups and services on a sixteen bed inpatient unit. In collaboration with patients and staff, plans and participates in community outings. Works in collaboration with members of a multidisciplinary team, attends team meetings, participates and documents on the patient's recovery plan. Works with patients on an individual basis to establish a personalized therapeutic program which is incorporated into the recovery plan. Provides training to other staff members on specific therapeutic activities. Writes weekly progress notes and documents on patient's group attendance. Works with patients to assist with transition to the community. Plans and oversees patients' outings and activities.

**Eligibility Requirement:** Candidates must have applied for and passed the Rehabilitation Therapist 2 (Therapeutic Recreation) exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator license. Incumbents in this class are required to travel.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

**To be considered for this position:**
