Position Description: There is a Transportation Engineer 3 (CE) position opportunity available in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, Office of Construction, in the Newington Administration Building. The position is in the P-4 (Engineering and Scientific) bargaining unit.

This position will be primarily dedicated to the development and administration of the Alternative Contracting program. This person will act as a team member related to the administration projects from conception to completion as well as development and maintenance of the related procedures and contracting documents. This position will require constant coordination with Transportation Engineers from the Office of Engineering and the Office of Construction during various stages of project design development and construction.

General duties will include: Acting as a working lead supervising DOT engineers, consulting engineers, and other DOT employees related to design and construction administration of highways and other transportation projects; acting as a team member related to the research and development of Design-Build, CMR, CMGC and other preliminary plans, specifications, solicitations, and contracts; acting as a subject matter expert related to the processes for selection of project delivery methods as well as alternative contracting methods, providing assistance and guidance during the procurement and construction phases for the selection of contractors or contracting teams and construction administration; drafting, and maintaining manuals, template procurement and other related documents serving as technical advisor for transportation projects; distributing, prioritizing, overseeing and reviewing unit work as assigned by a supervisor; providing staff training and assistance; conducting or assisting in conducting performance evaluations; acting as a liaison with other operating units, agencies, consultants, the Contracting Community and outside officials regarding policies and procedures; recommending policies and standards; preparing reports and correspondence; public speaking; oral and written presentations; related duties as required.

Preferred Knowledge, Qualifications, Skills and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of principles and practices involved in transportation construction engineering such as construction, surveys, and materials testing; considerable knowledge of highway, bridge, and facilities construction methods and materials; knowledge of administrative and financial controls with respect to transportation construction engineering plans, contracts, projects, and reports; experience with ConnDOT Utility, Right of Way, and Design practices and procedures; experience with alternative contracting methods, performance specifications, and quality assurance and its use in design and construction; possession of a current Professional Engineer (PE) licensure from the Department of Consumer Protection State Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors consistent with C.G.S. §20-302.

Eligibility: Candidates must have passed the Transportation Engineer 3 (CE) examination and be on a current examination list as of the closing date of this posting. State employees currently holding the title of Transportation Engineer 3 (CE) or those who have previously attained permanent status in the class since their most recent hire date may apply for lateral transfer.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Incumbents in this class may be exposed to some danger of injury or physical harm from highway or construction environments and a moderate degree of discomfort from exposure to year round weather conditions.
