Position Description: The Connecticut Department of Transportation currently has a Transportation Engineer 2 (Construction Engineering) or “(CE)” position opportunity in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, in District 4 (Thomaston). This position may be filled by lateral transfer, promotion or underfilled at the level of Transportation Engineer 1 (CE) or Transportation Engineer Trainee. The Transportation Engineer Trainee training program will be a two year training program. Upon successful completion of the training program, the incumbents will be promoted to the target classification of Transportation Engineer 1 (CE). After successful completion of one year as a Transportation Engineer 1 (CE), the incumbents will be promoted to Transportation Engineer 2 (CE). These positions are in the P-4 bargaining unit.

The duties of these positions may include: acts as chief inspector of highway construction projects; monitors contractor performance in accordance with plans and specifications; inspects and oversees inspection of culverts and drainage structures, bridge and structural foundations, pavements and other structures; checks method and performance of work including line and grade, strength and rigidity of forms, conformance of materials to specification requirement; samples materials and requests tests; notes unforeseen conditions and recommends specific changes in original plans and specifications; prepares daily labor, material and progress reports; collects necessary data and prepares monthly and final estimates for approval; inspects construction projects; acts as a team member in preparation of plans and estimates for construction or maintenance of bridges, structures, and highways; reviews shop plans; oversees collection, recording, preparation and analysis of data pertaining to materials testing and transportation planning; assists in budget preparation, report writing, general planning and administration of unit work from an engineering project coordination and technical stand point; prepares research and administrative reports; and other related duties as required.

Eligibility Requirement: In order to be considered for these opportunities, candidates must meet the minimum qualifications for the Transportation Engineer Trainee classification stated on the job specification. Transportation Engineer 1 (Construction Engineering) and Transportation Engineer 2 (Construction Engineering) candidates must be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for the applicable classification. DOT employees currently holding one of the above titles may apply for lateral transfer. DOT employees who are interested in these opportunities **must** apply to this posting in order to be considered.
