PROMOTION:

1. Incumbents in this class will be eligible for promotion without further competitive examination upon successful completion of the training program.
2. Incumbents in this class who meet the qualifications of the target class before the end of the training program must take and pass a competitive examination for the for the target class in order to be considered for promotion to the target class.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable. Applicants who do not submit all the requested documents will not be considered. In addition, the candidate pool resulting from these interviews may be used to fill future Connecticut Careers Trainee/Transportation Planner 1 positions in the Department within twelve months.
