**Position Description:** The Connecticut Department of Transportation currently has a Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering) or "(E)" position opportunity in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, Office of Engineering, Division of Design Services, Cost Estimating Unit, in Newington, CT. This position may be filled by lateral transfer, promotion, or outside hire and may be underfilled at the level of Transportation Engineer 1 (E). If hired or transferred at the Transportation Engineer 1 (E) level, the incumbent will be promoted to Transportation Engineer 2 (E), in accordance with the class specification. This position is in the P-4 bargaining unit.

Duties include: Preparing engineer's estimates for construction contracts; developing calendar day charts for construction contracts; conducting and documenting pre-award analysis of contractor bids; creating and maintaining a variety of documentation and records such as estimate tracking; communicating and coordinating with other Department units and external organizations such as consultant designers, performing other related duties as required.

**Preferred Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Considerable knowledge of cost estimating; considerable knowledge and familiarity with transportation engineering design and construction processes and construction contracts; considerable knowledge of the construction contract bidding and award process; considerable knowledge of principles and practices of civil engineering and related computer applications, considerable interpersonal and oral and written communication skills; considerable organizational, quantitative, analytical, problem solving and report development skills; familiarity with the Department's functions and organization.

**Eligibility Requirement:** In order to be considered for this opportunity, candidates must be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for the classification of Transportation Engineer 2 (E) or Transportation Engineer 1 (E). DOT employees currently holding one of the above classifications may apply for lateral transfer. DOT employees who are interested in this opportunity **must** apply to this posting in order to be considered.
