Position Description: There is a Transportation Engineer 3 (Construction Engineering) position opportunity currently available in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, Office of Construction, located in the Headquarters Building in Newington. This position is in the P-4 (Engineering and Scientific) bargaining unit.

The candidate selected for this position will assist a Transportation Supervising Engineer in the support and coordination of the Department's Standard Specification Committee and will supervise a designated group of employees, as well as perform complex engineering related tasks related to the maintenance and development of the Departments standard specifications and special provisions.

Duties will include: review and write specifications; research other states and agencies specifications, procedures, and processes; review and assist in developing legislation proposals related to specification language; coordinate other engineers in the development of and recommended use of special provisions; coordinate with other Department units, agencies, municipalities, federal agencies, and the construction industry in maintaining and compiling revisions to each subsection of the standard specifications; recommend proposals for new or revised specifications through the review and collection of lessons learned from other Department units; conduct performance evaluations; provide staff training; distribute, oversee and review unit work; prepare and review correspondence and reports; and may act as liaison with other operating units, other State Agencies, consultant staff, and other outside officials regarding unit procedures and construction standards; analyze problems and recommend effective solutions; and perform related duties as required.

Preferred Knowledge, Qualifications, Skills, and Abilities: Ability to work independently to research and carry out initiatives; considerable knowledge of principles and practices involved in administration of transportation construction projects, including Construction Manual procedures, surveying, project documentation, and materials testing; considerable knowledge of highway, bridge, and facilities construction methods and materials; knowledge of design development and estimating practices; knowledge of contract development and structure; knowledge of Department organization.

Possession of a current Engineer in Training (EIT) or Professional Engineer (PE) licensure from the Department of Consumer Protection State Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors consistent with C.G.S.§20-302 or a state with reciprocity to the State of Connecticut.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Knowledge, Skill and Ability:

Considerable knowledge of operational methodologies and established policies; considerable analytical, problem solving and technical report development skills; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; considerable ability to interpret and apply principles of information systems and technologies; ability to analyze plans and estimates; some supervisory ability.

Considerable knowledge of principles and practices involved in transportation construction engineering such as construction, surveys, geodetic surveys and materials testing; considerable knowledge of highway construction methods and materials; knowledge of administrative and financial controls with respect to transportation construction engineering plans, contracts, projects and reports.

Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must have passed the Transportation Engineer 3 (Construction Engineering) examination and be on the current examination list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this title. State employees currently holding this title or those who have attained permanent status since their last date of hire may apply for lateral transfer. Candidates not currently on the examination list are ineligible for this opportunity, but should take the [Transportation Engineer 3 \(Construction Engineering\) exam](#) to become eligible for future opportunities.
